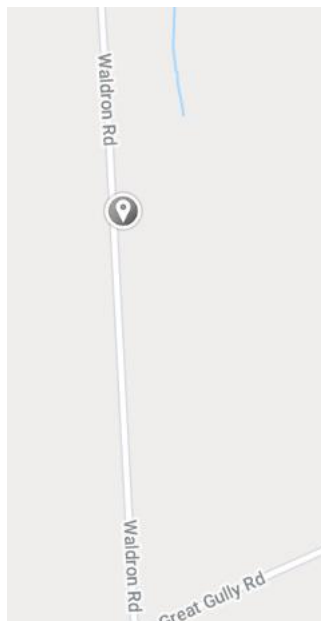


Allen Cemetery, Waldron Road, Springport, Cayuga County, New York.

This cemetery is next to the road on the east side, on the farm of Gary and Karen Gulliver [April 2020]; just under a half mile north of the intersection of Great Gully Road. A few stones are standing upright, and are listed as such; otherwise, the stones are off their stands and/or broken. I found several stone bases, but not a corresponding headstone nearby.

First Row, Left to Right

Silas Allen; died April 12, 1866 aged 85 years 3 months

Emily, wife of John W. Bartlett, daughter of Zimri and Abigail Allen; d. July 5, 1841 aged 23y 10m 11d
Abigail, wife of Zimri Allen; died July 27, 1828 aged 33y 6m 19d
[dual stone]

Emily, wife of John W.... [broken stone] aged 23y 9m 21d

Second Row, Right to Left

Ann M., wife of Zimri Allen; died August 17, 1858 aged 57y 7m

Zimri Allen; died October 14, 1869 aged 82y 8m 3d

Phebe {Beardsley}, wife of Gideon Allen; died April 26, 1840 aged 87y 10m 11d
Gideon Allen; died March 12, 1841 aged 94y 4m 12d
[dual stone, upright]

Lewis Allen, son of Zimri & Ann M.; died April 4, 1855 aged 23y 5m 9d
“Beloved in Life, Lamented in Death”

Third Row, Right to Left

Margaret Bell, wife of James Richardson; died April {15}, 183 {2} [1834?] “in the 28th year of her age”
[upright]

“In Memory of Mary, daughter of Peter & Castilla Flinn who died April 9th 1831 E. 15 years”
[upright; quote at bottom, very eroded]

{Zimri Allen had a third wife: Olive St. John}
