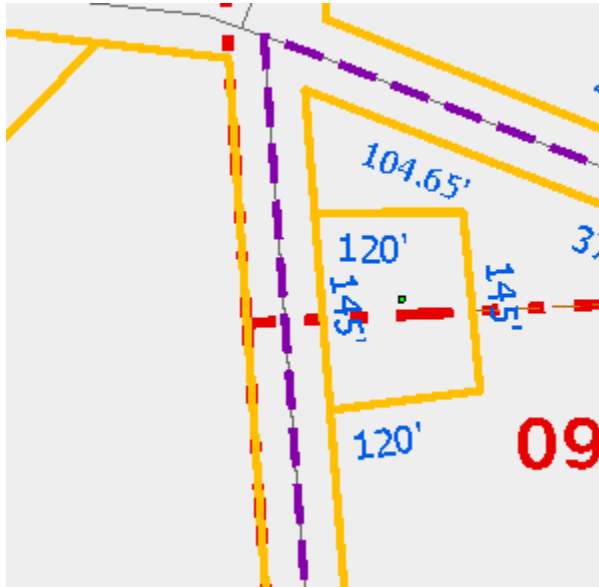


Thompson Cemetery, AKA Cross Road; Town of Springport.

This cemetery is on the east side of Cross Road, approximately 200 feet south of the intersection of Connors Road; this cemetery lies in the southwest corner of Lot 78 and the northwest corner of Lot 83.



Two deeds were found by Malcom Goodelle relating to this cemetery:

ECR 78, page 393: February 15, 1849. Jacob Smith of Springport to the Trustees of the First Presbyterian Society of Springport—28 rods for a graveyard.

ECR 78, pg 394: James Thompson of Springport to the Trustees of the First Presbyterian Church of Springport—33.75 rods for a graveyard.

This cemetery was originally inventoried by Frank Skilton and updated in September 1963 by Mable Crosby. Jessica Armstrong of the Cayuga County Historian's Office visited this cemetery in November 2020. Below is a compilation of Skilton, Crosby, and Armstrong; names are in alphabetical order.

*Denotes stone not found in November 2020 and entries are based on Crosby and Skilton.

[Notes from Crosby] {Notes from Skilton}

Adams, Mary W.: "In memory of Mary Adams, wife of John, who died August 18, 1822 age 71y 4m 19d."

Bodley, William H.: age 72y; no dates are found on this stone, however, Marion Gulliver (1966), states "died August 1854." Crosby has Co. D, 15th NY Cavalry; but the stone standing now states Company B.

Bower, Sarah, daughter of Benjamin & Mary: died June 15, 1833 [1832] age 18y 8m 28d

Davis, Jesse: died March 14, 1843 age 70y 7m 6d. Epitaph is Revelations 11:13. Footstone: JD

*Davis, John C.; son of Thomas T. & __: born October 25, 1856; died February 1, 1861

Davis, Polly; wife of Jesse: died December 14, 1840 [1843]; age 59y 17d.

Epitaph: "She departed this life in full Faith in her Lord Jesus Christ."

*Edwards, Mary; wife of Charles R.: died June 4, 1831 in her 22nd year.

Everitt, Abraham; son of James & Lavinia: died December 9, 1873 age 13y 2m 23d. Footstone.

Everitt, Catherine [Van Sickle]; wife of James S.: died December 8, 1841 age 23y 4m 17d

Everitt, David: died January 3, 1875 in his 96th year of his age. Footstone, GAR marker.

Everitt, Sarah; wife of David: died August 2, 1844 age 61y 1m 17d. Epitaph: "Faith in her God, she welcom'd death, a sweet release from pain; and gently yielding up her breath, she died to live again."

Everitt, James; son of James and Lavinia: died November 16, 1877 age 22y 10m 21d [12d]

Everitt, James S.: died June 17, 1866 age 56y 1m 28d.

Everitt, John V.: 1856-1936

Everitt, Lavinia; [wife of James S.]: born November 2, 1820; died March 15, 1896. See Powers. Second marriage. See NYS Census: 1855 Springport #32; 1865 Union Springs #60.

Everitt, Millissent Ann; daughter of David & Sarah: died July 18, 1838 age 24y 11m 3d.

Epitaph: "Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord."

Everitt, William: 1863-1920

Humphrey, Agnes Rose [Rosa]; daughter of John & Ann: died September 21, 1861 age 3y 2m 17d

Humphrey, Fanny; daughter of John & Ann: died June 10, 1863 age 17y 4m 6d

Humphrey, Mary Ann; daughter of John & Ann: died August 10, 1861 age 10y 1m 4d

Humphrey, Thomas; son of John & Ann: died October 9, 1861 age 4y [5y] 3m 16d

Hunt, Sarah: died April 23, 1873 age 57y [67y] 29d. "My Mother." {Might be mother of Polly Lewis.}

Leappard, Infant; daughter of J. J. & J.: died March 14, 1863

*Lowry, James and Joanna [Jeanna]: See Lowry Family Cemetery, Cross Road, Springport.

*Mercereau, Fayette; son of Aaron & Maria: died March 7, 1837 age 1m 8d

*Mercereau, David P., son of Aaron & Maria; died April 18, 1836 age 5m 10d

Mercereau, Maria Davis; wife of Aaron: born April 28, 1810; died February 28, 1873. Footstone.

Mercereau, Mary D.; daughter of Aaron & Maria: died October 30, 1860 age 19y 9m 4d [1840-1860]
Epitaph: "Dearest Mary, thou hast left us here, thy loss we deeply feel, but tis God that hath (bereft), He ___ all our sorrows heal."

Pinckney, Charlotte; wife of John: died November 26, 1845 age 30y 9m 26d. Footstone.

Pinckney, Harriet A.; wife of James, Jr.: died February 20, 1850 age 26y 7m 12d. Footstone.

*Pinckney, Harriet E.; daughter of John & Charlotte: died June 19, 1846 age 4y 10m 2d

Powers-See Everitt; to the right of this obelisk is a stone: "Mother"

Powers, John R.: died September 8, 1846 age 32y 9m 5d.

Married to Lavinia (see Everitt), she is listed as Petitioner for Letters of Admin., C2, page 84; her burial record is listed on this monument. She may be daughter of John and Theodosia Van Sickle (see 1850).

Powers, Thomas V. [D; GAR marker]: died February 22, 1865 [1866] age 21y 4m 13d.

Resides in 1850 with John and Theodosia Van Sickle (Aurelius #1525)

Richardson, Charlotte; wife of Samuel: died November 2, 1849 age 56y 2m 22d

*Shearman, Dr. Jonathan: [No dates, didn't find these stones]

*Shearman, Dorinda; daughter of Seth & Lydia Smith: died December 11, 1823 age 34y 2m

Sloan, Isabell; [wife of Samue]: died December 25, 1879 age 75y 4m 25 days (very eroded)

*Sloan, Samuel: died May 5, 1853 age 49y 3m 16d

Smith, Catherine; wife of John. Stone is broken in half. A piece lying on the ground behind the name states died June 29, 1840 [1842] age 75 years, but the two parts are made of different material.

Smith, George: born May 4, 1807; died October 14, 1867

Smith, Magdelin[e] Davis; [wife of George]: born November 18, 1806; died March 23, 1866

Smith, Jacob: died April 16, 1836 in his 59th year. Footstone.

*Smith, Jacob; [son of George, 2nd & Maria]: 1883-1884

Smith, John: died March 25, 1839 age 75y 5m. Epitaph half buried.

Smith, Polly; wife of Jacob: died February 14, 1856 age 75y 11m 22d. Stone is facedown, but liftable.
Epitaph: "Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth you saith the Spirit that they may rest from their labours and (hear, their) works do follow them."

Smith, Sarah: died May 17, 1832 age 34y 4m. Epitaph: "All you that read with little care who turn away and leave _____ do not forget that you must die and be intom'd as well as I."

Smith, William V. [B.; son of George]: died September 10, 1850 age 5y [5y 6m 7d]

George Smith (1867), Magdalen Davis Smith, and William B. Smith are all listed on one large stone; two small stones to the right and left of the large monument contain no data.

*Thompson, Abigail Lovell: born September 19, 1795; died March 27, 1887.

Thompson, Alexander: born March 8 [18], 1774; died August 26, 1849.

Thompson, Alexander; [son of Alexander & Letitia]: born January 7, 1813; died December 4, 1864.

Thompson, James: died September 23, 1856 age 80y 8m 15d. This is a large obelisk, was down on its side and half buried. Too heavy to lift.

Thompson, Letitia; [daughter of John & Mary Adams]: born February 8, 1776; died October 16, 1856.

*Thompson, Sally; wife of James; died February 27, 1811 (1816?) age 29y 3m 8d. I could not check the data of this entry, it is most likely on the toppled obelisk of James. Footstone: S. T.

Alexander Thompson, Jr. and Sr., and Letitia Adams Thompson's stones are enclosed within an iron fence. The stones of Letitia and Alexander, Jr., are broken.

Van Sickle, Abraham: died [September 30, 1859 age 30y 7m 5d]. Broken and eroded. Footstone: AVS

*Van Sickle, Garrett: [born NJ in 1740, died 1810. He was a General in the Revolution in the NY Line. He died in Huntington County, New Jersey.]

Van Sickle, John: died February 20, 1861 age 80y 7m 27d. Footstone: JVS

Van Sickle, Lydia Ann; [daughter of John & Catherine]: died July 29, 1841 age 23y 8m 23d [2y 3m 8d]

Van Sickle, Margaret: died August 2, 1829 age 32y 3m 15d. "In Memory of...who died..."

Van Sickle, Mary C.; [daughter of Thomas & Sarah]: died December 27, 1841 age 3y 10m 7d. Epitaph difficult to read, but appears to be the same as Mary D. Mercereau.

Van Sickle, Oliver; [son of John & Theodosia]: died March 11, 1836 [1833] age 1y 8m 18d [8d]

Van Sickle, Sarah M.; wife of Thomas: born July 18, 1810; died May 20, 1888

Van Sickle, Theodosia; wife of John: died March 13, 1865 age 70y 9m 29d

Van Sickle, Thomas: died October 3, 1843 age 38y 2m 26d. Epitaph eroded.

Van Sickle, William: died December 24, 1836 age 22y 2m 10d

Van Sickle, Ann; [wife of Garrett]: died December 22, 1829 age 77y 8m 20d. "In Memory of...who died..."
Footstone: AVS

Warrick, Isaac: died [August 23, 1851 age 66y 5m 21d]. Stone is broken into several pieces.

*Warrick, Catherine; daughter of Isaac & Catherine: died July 1, 1831 age 1y 11m 7d
