 lot line to the place of beginning Containing One hundred and one acres and sixty
 four rods as surveyed by Shadrach Crane be the same more or less and being also
 the same premises on which the said Dorothy now resides To have and to hold
 the above described premises together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances
