# TOWN OF GENOA.

## NOTE.

The matter in this directory is arranged on the following plan :

1. Name of person, thus—Jones, John.
2. Name of wife, if any, in parentheses, thus—( Mary )
3. Number of children *under eighteen years of age* if any, thus—2 c.
4. If person is on route of a rural delivery carrier, the rural carrier's route number appears thus—r d 4. The postoffices from which the carriers issue appear in the introduction to each town. Should no rural delivery number or postoffice address appear, the postoffice address will be the name of hamlet or village in which person dwells as appears at the end under 7.
5. Occupation, (if farmer, special branch engaged in if any.) Where a farm is not occupied, and no occupation given, "laborer" generally understood.
6. Real estate owned or occupied. If a farm, number of acres in and stock on same.
7. Location of house or farm by reference to the lots of military survey as per map of county. Also by indicating road either by giving its name or general direction across the lot. Should lot number not be given, the village or hamlet in which person resides is given, which may be located by consulting map.

 Always read the introduction to each town.

ABBREVIATIONS : c, children ; h, house ; r d, rural delivery ; w, wife ; a, acres ; bds, boards ; dau, daughter ; e—w, east and west ; n—s, north and south.

The town of Genoa bore originally the name of Milton. It was organized under that name January 27, 1789, being the first town to be organized within the present limits of Cayuga county. The southern portion of the town was taken in 1817 to form the town of Lansing in Tompkins county. The name Genoa was adopted April 6, 1808.

The Lake road follows the shore of Cayuga lake at some distance from the shore, running north and south through lots 1 and 2, following the east line of lots 12 and 22 and through 23 and 32.

The Ridge road runs north and south through King Ferry and Goodyears.

The next north and south road eastward is called for convenience the Belltown road. Belltown being the name by which the hamlet which appears on the map as West Genoa is commonly known.

The Indian Fields road runs through lots 7, 17 and 27.

Maple street is the recently adopted name for the road running east and west following the north line of lots 29, 30 and 31. The other roads, so far as they have been named in the directory, will be easily recognized.

The rural delivery routes which cover the town are as follows :

- No. 21, from Locke.
- No. 22, from Locke.
- No. 23, from Locke.
- No. 24, from Genoa.
- No. 25, from Atwaters.
- No. 26, from King Ferry.
- No. 27, from King Ferry.

The post-offices at East Genoa, Five Corners and Goodyears have been discontinued ; Genoa, King Ferry, Atwaters and Clearview remain.

The Empire Long Distance Telephone has stations at King Ferry and Genoa.

The Miller Telephone system for farms and villages has numerous connections in the town and is gradually increasing its patrons. Long distance messages may be sent to the regular



Bell or Empire stations and repeated over the Miller lines. The independent telephone lines (the Automatic in Auburn for example) have direct connection with the Miller lines.

Stage lines run daily from Genoa and King Ferry to Auburn. Three times a week from Genoa to Ithaca. Twice daily from Locke to Genoa to connect with the Lehigh Valley trains at Locke.

The Lehigh Valley railroad running from Ithaca to Auburn has two stations in the town on Cayuga Lake shore, Atwaters and Clearview, the latter, but a short distance from King Ferry and connected with King Ferry by stage.
